Review

- 1. Moral **discernment** is in the judgment (moral **conscience**)
- 2. Morality (moral good or evil) is in the free will
- 3. Moral Evil is a decision that creates more harm than good
- 4. Choices have consequences: obligations and responsibilities in justice
- 5. (Actual) Sin is a conscious decision act contrary to Core Values
- 6. All sin involves injustice
- 7. "Mortal" sin is a decision to change our **fundamental life option** against our Core Values
- 8. The consequence of sin is a rupture of **relationships** (self, others, and God)
- 9. Sin Unto Death is blasphemy or despair
