# Reconciliation (Making Amends)

- 1. Asking for healing of our character defects (self)
- 2. Seek reconciliation with **others** 
  - a. Acknowledgement of wrong (confession)
  - b. Expression of sorrow and regret (contrition)
  - c. Making good the harm (restitution)
- 3. Reconciliation with **God** in the Body of Christ
- 4. Training of the will (penance not punishment)
